Participants who fish at five or more designated fishing areas between March 19 and June 19 and turn in their completed forms to the Oenslager Nature Center between June 20 and July 7, 2024 will receive an award (while supplies last). This program is open to all ages; one award per person.

Check off the park and write down the types (if known) and quantity of fish you caught on the line provided on the back of this flier. Please fish in designated fishing areas only and obey all fishing limits posted. A fishing license is ONLY required at Chippewa Lake.
